POSITION PURPOSE

Under general direction provide support and encouragement to assist students in learning the specific progressive or competitive program. Ensure safety and cleanliness of the program area and adherence to all YMCA safety standards and rules.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Provide a safe environment that allows members and participants to learn YMCA programs.
- Conduct YMCA program instruction in accordance with YMCA program standards.
- Encourage and support youth and adults to provide an enjoyable YMCA experience.
- Evaluate program skills; complete progress reports for each session; complete communications for parents/participants. Incorporate character development objectives into the program to reinforce the YMCA values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

• Ability to express or exchange ideas by means of spoken word to impart oral information and to convey detailed, spoken instructions to staff, members, children, and volunteers accurately, quickly, and loudly. Ability to perceive the nature of sounds by ear; ability to lift and carry 50-75 pounds; ability to maintain body equilibrium to prevent falling. Ability to move about on foot quickly; ability to stoop, kneel, crouch and crawl. Ability to sit or stand for long periods of time. Ability to judge distances and spatial relationships so as to see objects where they actually are and clearly see at 20 inches or less and 20 feet or more.
